

Library Holding Inventory

As far a I know, we have never completed an inventory of our holdings. Patty Hurtack and I found that many of the books on our discard lists were not on our shelves. The volunteers and myself will begin working on an inventory throughout the fall and winter months. I will do a practice inventory on a small group of books (paper backs) so I will be able to help volunteers get started. I will also work to get the books on our shelves, correctly and consistently entered into our catalog as well. This will help patrons when looking for books in our library and staff when pulling books for discards.

Grants

The CCLS board approved our Intent to Apply in August and I have been working on the NYS Construction Grant to submit September 13. Thankfully Mike E. has applied for this grant in the past and has been able to answer questions. Thank you Mike. This grant will finish a remodel of the Community Room, Children's Area, office, little middle room as well as build climate controlled enclosure for the 100+ year old reference collection and install a fuel efficient HVAC system for heating and air conditioning. Work on this will begin in Fall of 2025 if we receive funding.

I have also approached the Lenna Foundation about deadlines for a grant to re place the carpet the main room and replace the free-standing shelving. The next deadline is April 2025.
